#### POSTLUDE

Here are some follow up questions based on the sermon "Who Will Take the Garbage Out?" Read Zechariah 5:5–11 and answer these questions:

- 1. To put it mildly, this is a confusing vision! Here is some help. Jesus is the LORD'S Messenger. The woman stuck in the flying garbage can stands for Babylonian idolatry. The storks are God's appointed means to return sin to Shinar—an ancient name for Babylon.
- 2. How does the LORD's Messenger demonstrate His authority over idolatry and sin in this vision? In your life?
- 3. You do not need to live in the pain and brokenness of past sin. How does the LORD's Messenger finally and fully remove all of the messes in your life?
